
60 JFK Street Offices, Harvard Faculty of Arts and Sciences



60 JFK Street was built in 1923 as a lodging house for students.

In the process of renovating the building to create offices for the Harvard FAS Office of Planning and Physical Resources, we removed bland features of a 1970's renovation and infilled dado paneling, casings, cornices, paneled doors detailed to match the original neo-Georgian design. This transformation restored the architectural spirit of the original building, while meeting the Owner's programmatic needs and complying with current code requirements.
