
Lobby, MIT Chemical Engineering



Centrally located on the MIT campus, the lobby of Building 66 is a thoroughfare that extends the Institute's "Infinite Corridor" circulation path.

The building was designed by I.M.Pei in the 1960s, and its original finishes were dated and worn after almost 35 years.

Chemical Engineering wanted to organize the accumulation of trash and mail receptacles in the lobby, provide new building directories, and add video displays that highlight research activities underway in the department and announce upcoming events.

New light fixtures, wood paneling and benches establish a refreshed image for the department at this high-traffic entrance to the building.
