This small classroom is used both for lecture-style instruction and for seminar and laboratory work. Botanical fossils are placed on the large tables, where students set up and use microscopes to examine the specimens.

Ample blackboard space, excellent lighting and movable furniture were critical goals of the professors using the classroom.

Acoustic tile ceiling was installed between the heavy timber beams, which allowed for recessed, indirect lighting while exposing building's historic structure.
