
Lobby Renovation, Peabody Museum at Harvard University



One of the few remaining double-height spaces in this museum, the entry lobby previously suffered from bad lighting, an ad-hoc collection of poorly-placed furniture, an incongruous paint scheme, and general neglect.

Our renovation of the lobby included a new cherry information and sales desk, located to the side of the main circulation path. We installed new lighting fixtures throughout, and we selected deliberately understated paint colors to emphasize the existing architecture.
