Strominger Dining Room, Currier House, Harvard College



Located in the basement of a 1970 dormitory, this private dining room formerly featured exposed concrete columns and bare white plaster walls.

New oak pilasters (which conceal the concrete columns) give the room an organizational structure suggestive of traditional architecture but with contemporary detailing. New light fixtures, carpeting and furniture help to create an elegant atmosphere for special events.
