Wright Hall renovation, Episcopal Divinity School



By adding an accessible path leading to the entrance doors, installing an interior wheelchair lift that connects the entry with the upper and lower levels, and reconfiguring restrooms, this project made the original library building at the Episcopal Divinity School in Cambridge fully accessible to all.

Now used as administrative offices, the lower level was reconfigured to create a light-filled suite for staff and student services. The building's archaic steam heating system was replaced with a hot water baseboard system.
